15-01: KSC Pressure Vessel Systems Approval

Ground Safety Check List:

Does servicing equipment or GSE being used require a Pressure Vessel System (PVS) certification prior to use?

If yes, has a PVS certification been obtained?

If no, has a PVS Exclusion form been approved by the PVS Manager prior to operations?

CONCLUSION

If operations include the servicing of a pressurized ORU or the system is considered pressurized, approval from the KSC Pressure Vessel Systems (PVS) Manager is required prior to servicing operations beginning. The KSC PVS Manager will review the pressure system to determine if the system requires a PVS certification or if the pressure system is exempt from certification. If the system is exempt, a PVS Exclusion form is required to be filled out and approved by the KSC PVS Manager prior to operating the system. This information will be included in the approved GSDP.
